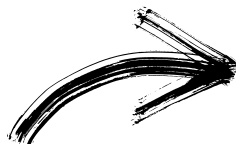

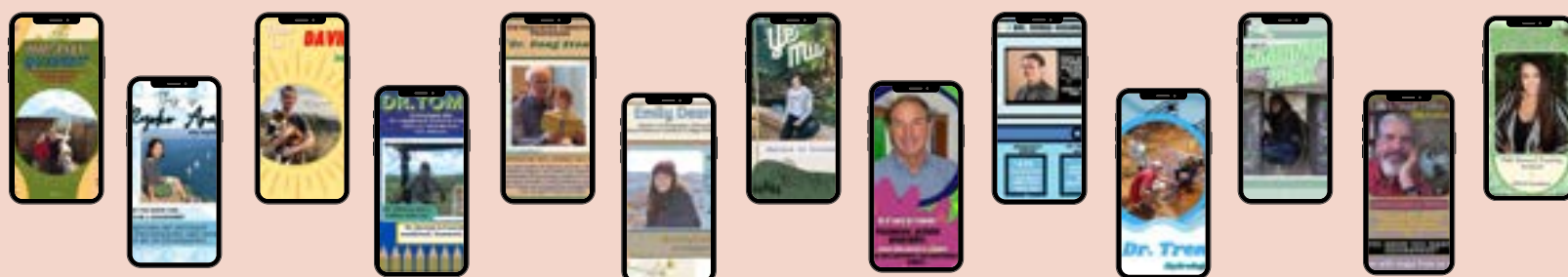
## ALUMNI PANEL

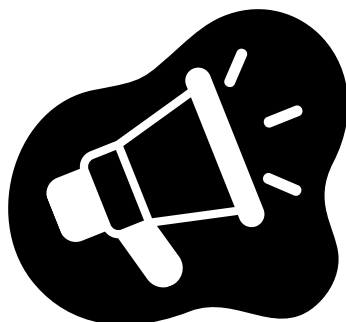
